

#### **Connecting Activities:**

<b>Being a facilitator</b> The teacher as the facilitator: We need to focus on modeling for the students the way to ask questions based on the desired outcomes to demonstrate that learning is achieved by getting the students to understand how they gathered the data & use skillful thinking to make a conclusion.
