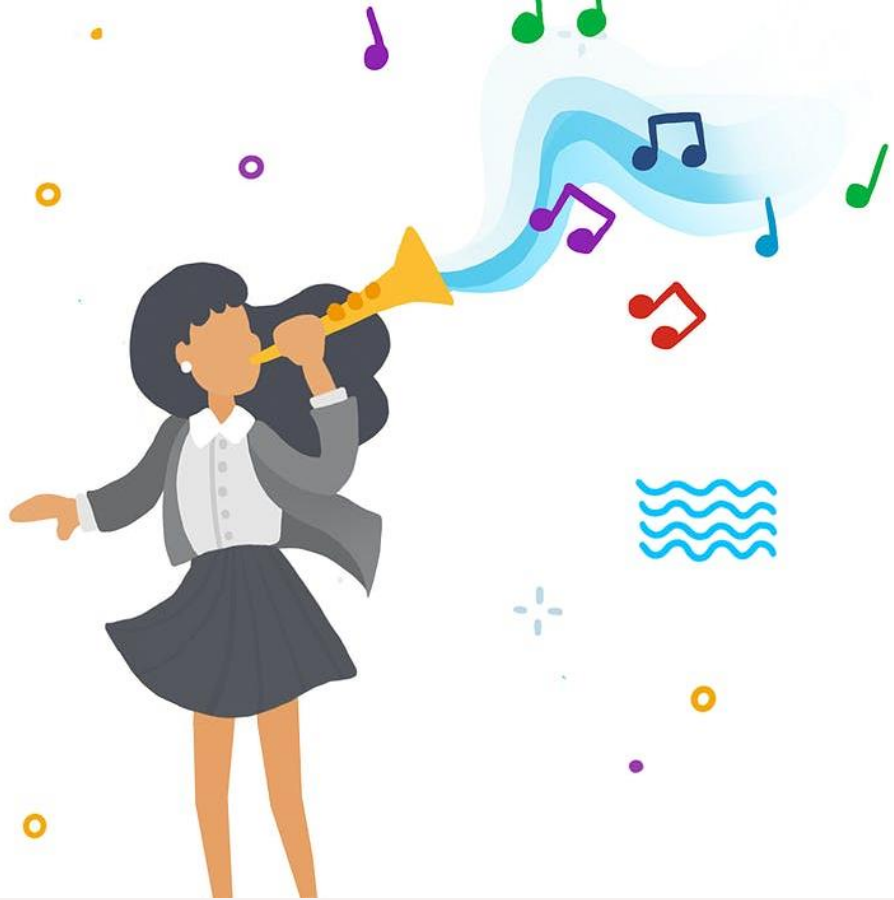

Foundational Skills

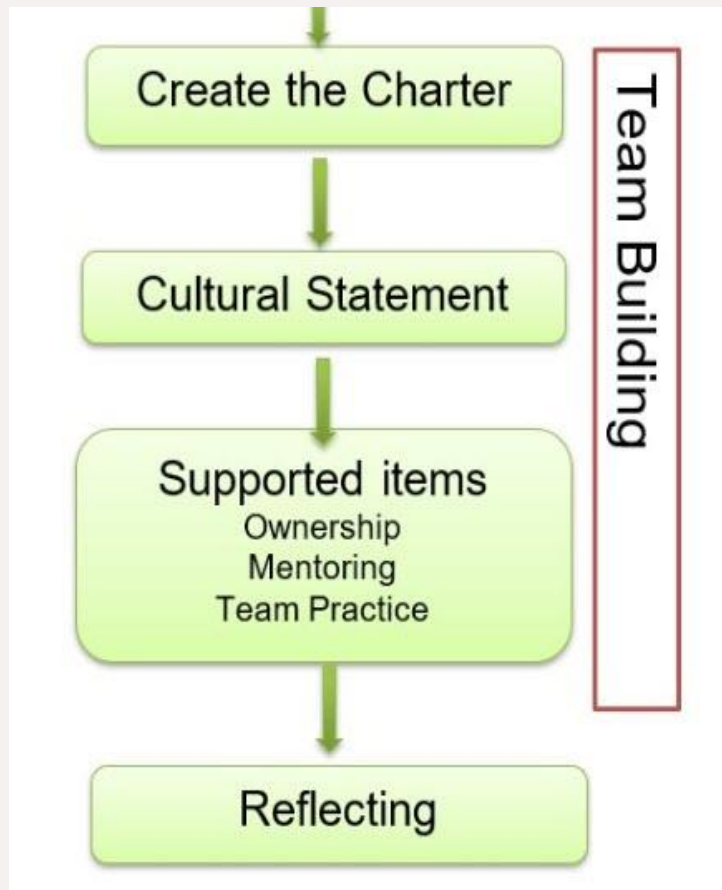
Wisdom: good decisions and taking the path that provides value to all (society)

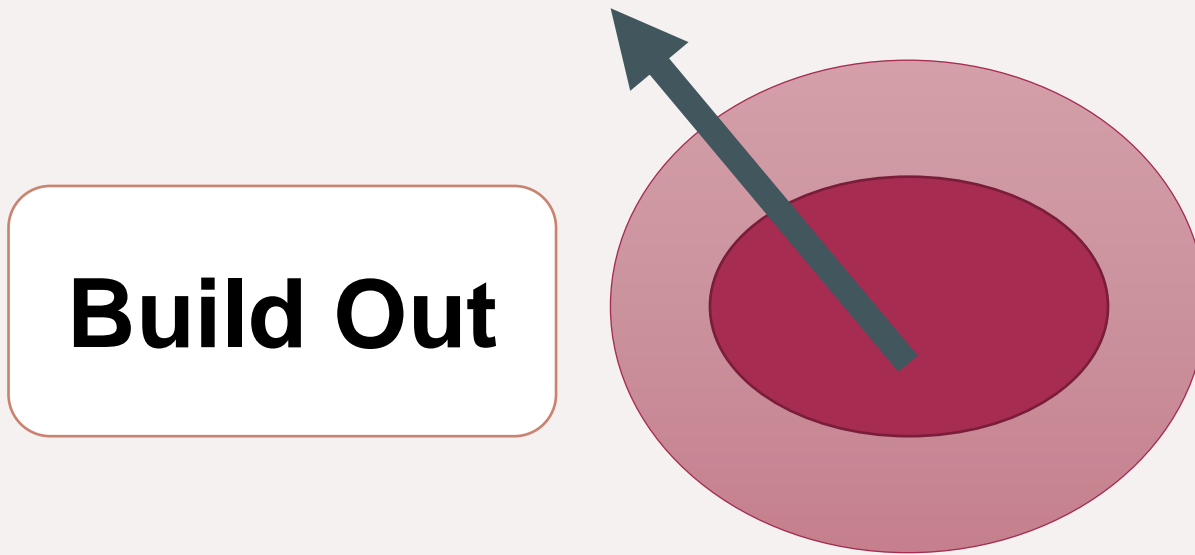
