





# How to Start-Peer Learning-My Role

<p><b>Overview</b></p> <p><b>Owning your learning</b></p> 	<p>The peer learning process is to follow the <b>on-line</b> project-based learning (PBL) process tutorial (about you-team creation-problem-solving-reporting) with your learning buddy, reading the articles and answering the questions.</p> <p>Your goal is to understand the articles and write down your summary in your notebook, the main points of these articles with your learning buddy (Mentor).</p> <p>The facilitator is there to answer questions of understanding related to the text and process.</p>
<p><b>Choose your learning buddy</b></p> 	<p>She/He is your mentor, and you are his/her mentor in the learning process. Be kind and listen to each other. The goal is for both of you to learn what's on the web pages.</p>
<p><b>Being a mentor</b></p> 	<p>How can I support and help my learning buddy to understand the process we are following? Can I inspire and motivate my learning buddy to learning while I am also learning the material? How can we assess each other on the knowledge we are gaining?</p>

Both read the hot linked document and discuss. What is it telling you? What is the main theme? Write it down. How will you remember it?</p>
<p><b>Learning Outcomes</b></p> 	<p><b>What's the outcome</b></p> <p>How are we going to ensure that the learning outcomes are met? What are the outcomes we expect for this section of the process? Life skills, how do they fit in my life?</p>
